Factory in Pittsburgh won a third ULI Award for Excellence. Flair Tower, The Morgan at Loyola Station, Niketown, The Bernardin and the Streets of Woodfield are among other notable projects of the company in the Chicagoland area.

Dan has been a frequent speaker at meetings and conventions of the Urban Land Institute and the International Council of Shopping Centers. He has served as a ULI Council Member and on many ULI panels, including panels in Krakow, Poland and West Palm Beach, Florida, and was a member of the ULI Awards Jury. Dan graduated from the University of Alberta in Canada where he was recently honored as a recipient of the Distinguished Alumni Award. Additionally, he serves on the Board of Regents and is a 2009 Recipient of the Order of Merit with Loyola University, serves on the Board of Directors of the Knapp School of Entrepreneurship at IIT, Board of directors for LINK Unlimited, and, with his wife Iris, has established an educational scholarship fund to benefit the children of fallen US Marines.
