After receiving her bachelor's degree in architecture from Turin Polytechnic in 1982, Emanuela Recchi went on to complete graduate courses in Design Management at Pratt Institute in NYC, and in Project Management at both OICE and Milan Polytechnic. Thereafter, she collaborated with several architecture studios, namely Gabetti & Isola, Rafael Vinoly and Gino Valle. In 1984, under Skidmore, Owing & Merrill in NYC, she held the role of project manager for the design and construction of the World Trade Center in Genoa.

From 1985 to 1989, her professional career continued as project manager at Recchi S.p.A. Costruzioni Generali; having been appointed to their board of directors and their technical committee in 1989, she and her teams were tasked with growing the real estate sector. Since 1999, she has served as vice-president of Recchi Ingegneria e Partecipazioni, and, since 2009, as president of Recchiengineering.

She has been an active member of FRICS (Fellows of The Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors) since 2014, and, furthermore, of the advisory board at the Department of Architecture & Design at Turin Polytechnic, and also of the executive committee at Urban Land Institute Italy, both since 2015. From 2014 to 2017, she served as vice-president at Assoimmobiliare, where, as of 2020, she has been a general board member and president of their innovation committee. Most recently, in July 2021 she was named chair of Urban Land Institute Italy.
